APPENDIX 5 - WADHAM COLLEGE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

The College aspires to minimise the adverse impact of all its activities on the environment.

In particular:

- 1. The College will minimise use of energy consistent with acceptable levels of heating and other needs, and will seek to use cleaner sources wherever possible.
- 2. All members will minimise the consumption of resources consistent with the maintenance of proper levels of business, and will use recycled products wherever appropriate. They will ensure that the maximum possible amount of waste is recycled and that environmentally hazardous waste is disposed of safely.
- 3. The College will show proper concern in its use of chemical products and synthetic materials taking account of their environmental impact and biodegradability.
- 4. The College will encourage the management of its land in such a way that the environmental impact and conservation are considered.
- 5. When purchasing goods or services, the College will take into account the long term cost, including the cost to the environment.
- 6. The responsible College Officer for environment matters will be the Domestic Bursar who will review progress regularly with appropriate SU representatives.
